







in-house production

We prefer to work locally. This keeps us very flexible and is better for the environment. We are extremely proud that we manufacture half of our products in-house. A close-knit team of enthusiastic craftspeople work in our own factory in Goirle, making coat racks and entrance hall accessories. Above all, they can repair damaged products and give them a second life. Our suppliers are located near to us too: 80% are within a 100km radius. This way, we can adapt quickly and it is better for the environment.

reduce

How can we transport products as efficiently—and therefore as sustainably—as possible? This is a key principle in the design of our products. We use flat packaging to keep the volume as small as possible.

repair

Many of our products are nearly indestructible and last a lifetime. That's why we offer a 25-year warranty. If something does break, we repair it in our own workshop in Goirle or send a replacement part.

recycle

A large part of our collection is made from steel and aluminum—materials that can be infinitely recycled without any loss of quality. We also work with PET felt, made from recycled PET bottles.



materials

Since our family firm was established in 1972 we have had a preference for honest, sustainable materials. We have a soft spot for powder-coated steel and aluminium. Robust materials that last a long time and are simple to recycle. That's why we offer an impressive 25-year warranty on many of our products.

steel

Powder-coated steel is strong and requires little maintenance. Moreover, steel is 100% recyclable—it can be infinitely recycled without any loss of quality.


aluminum

sustainable design



And with one of our latest products - the waste sorting bin Ditch - we help offices and public spaces throughout Europe to separate refuse. Above all, Ditch is completely recyclable and equipped with internal bins made from recycled plastic.

We manage the transport of most of our products ourselves. That means that we can plan our routes as efficiently as possible and, in doing so, save a lot of unnecessary kilometres.

Our trucks always leave fully laden and return – if possible – fully laden with materials from our suppliers.

packaging

In packaging for our products, we are always looking for the balance between maximum protection and as little use of materials as possible. Where possible, we give packaging materials a second life. Increasingly often, we take the packaging materials away with us after delivery of products to clients. Great for the client, better for the environment. Moreover, we have taken the first step toward a fully electric fleet, aiming to further reduce our CO2 emissions.
